PARADE DAY SCHEDULE, OCTOBER 25, 2008



WESTERN HIGH SCHOOL ORANGE AVENUE "BACK" LOT
Please do not park or assemble anywhere else.

9:00am Volunteers arrive at Western High School to set up. Any additional warm bodies are welcome.

10:30am: Registration, fees, and forms. You cannot march unless all your forms are filled out and you have paid your parade fee of \$20 (if paying by check, payable to Kingsmen Starcorps Inc. and put KAC/AHP 2008 on the memo line). If you are a guest, we will fit you with either a cadet or a performance shirt.

11:00am Section warmups and rehearsals. Last chance to check phrasing, articulation, and equipment work.

12:00pm Ensemble music together in concert formation. First chance to hear the battery and horns together!

12:30pm Set marching formation. Sequence is as follows:
STREET BEAT
ROLL OFF
BLUE MEANIES AND WITCHES
STREET BEAT
ROLL OFF
MICKEY MOUSE CLUB MARCH
BASS DRUM BEAT

March sequence several times to get used to the street beat and the transitions.

2:00pm Lunch (provided) in the parking lot.

3:00pm Clean up and police parking lot--as much help as we can get breaking camp will be greatly appreciated. All marchers into half uniforms for the commute, changing in the Western HS parking lot.

3:30pm Leave Western and caravan to the PEARSON PARK disbanding area. We will park here and finish dressing into full uniform.

4:30pm KAC Volunteer drivers begin shuttling marchers to Assembly area at Broadway and Manchester. We need drivers and/or SUVs or minivans to help with this. There is no parade shuttle this year.

5:30pm All marchers meet at the Assembly area with full uniform and instrument or equipment.

6:00pm Step off. We are sequenced near the beginning of the parade.

After the parade we will circle up at the park prior to dismissal. We will get uniforms back from our guests at this time.

8:00pm DON JOSE Arrrrgh, matey! Thar be treasure to behold!

PARADE DAY CHECKLIST

- Self--with a song in your heart
- Instrument or equipment--clean, shiny, and ready to go
- Insurance card or info
- \$20

IF YOU OWN A CADET (cleaned, of course)

- Cadet with citation cord
- Sash and buckle
- Pants/Skirt/Suspender tie
- Cumberbund with drop
- Shako with plume
- Dinkles/Boots/Black socks
- Black gloves
- Member T-shirt
- Bowling shirt (to loan to a deserving guest--please hang on to until a request is made for your size)

IF YOU DON'T OWN A CADET

- White V-neck T-shirt
- Black pants
- Black military shoes/black socks
- Black gloves

Kingsmen uniform etiquette applies when in Cadet or Performance (Bowling) shirt. No eating or drinking anything other than water. No smoking, no profanity, no PDA's. (There was a special one-time exemption granted to Ray and Madge, and they handled it with great respect.) Finally, we do not break ranks once we are under Drum Major control. From that point until the dismissal after circle-up, we are the KINGSMEN and

have no reason for existence other than to stun the crowd and support each other.
